After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.

The petitioner had approached this Court being aggrieved by the trial Court, having turned down his request for putting a question during cross-examination to the complainant regarding his business.

Learned counsel representing the complainant has however, submitted that the complainant was into film production and that in fact during the course of his cross-examination he has also stated to the effect

that he had invested money in film production through M/s N.S.Production, to the tune of approximately ₹ 4 crores.

In view of the fact that the complainant has disclosed the nature of business and also while bearing in mind that the petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition, no further direction is required to be issued. The petition, as such, is dismissed as withdrawn.
