Petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to release an amount of Rs.66,262/- i.e. the security amount qua construction work of shops at Langah Market, Dhaliwal.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the work in question, if at all, had been allotted to the Batala Urban Estate Cooperative Labour & Construction Society in the year 2001/2002.

The present petitioner at best may be a member of the society.

Counsel was repeatedly called upon to show the work order in relation to the work in question that had been allotted to the society. He has been unable to do so.

Presuming that the work in question had been allotted to the society in question even the claim qua security deposit ought to have been made by the society.

Clearly under such circumstances even if any claim for return of security amount was to survive it would be only the society which can raise such a claim/prayer.

The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner in his individual capacity.

Prayer made in the petition, as such, is found to be misconceived.

The present order was dictated in Open Court.

Confronted with a situation whereby this Court was dismissing the petition, counsel seeks withdrawal of the same.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
