Main Case

Learned counsel for respondent No.1-Punjabi
University, Patiala submits that the present writ petition is
rendered infructuous in view of decision taken in the meeting
dated 29.11.2018. Minutes whereof have been placed on record
vide Annexure R-A-1.

2. Learned counsel further submits that the prayer in the
petition is to allow the teachers working in the Colleges affiliated

to the University to become members of Punjabi University Teachers Association (PUTA) so that they can vote and contest in the elections of PUTA.

3. Learned counsel for the University has drawn my attention to the concluding part of the minutes whereby, following recommendation has been made:-

“Whereas, earlier, Constituent colleges were not establishment or not established in much numbers but committee realized that in new context/reference, the teachers of constituent colleges are required separate representations. Therefore, they can be considered/included in the Ordinance 1994 of University Calendar Vol.III, Part-II with the name of Punjabi University Constituent College Teacher Association (PUCCTA) as separate chapter and separate platform and the committee is hereby recommended for the same.”

4. In view of the aforesaid, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to agitate their cause in the event the recommendation above is not implemented.
