Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to get the FIR registered in the case.

Reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Navneet Singh Mahal, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Jalandhar already placed on record on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3 shows that the police has already taken appropriate action in the complaint submitted by the petitioner and an FIR No.140 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC has been registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar on 25.07.2017 regarding the alleged occurrence dated 21.07.2017. Even the information as derived from the official website does indicate that the case is pending before the trial Court for framing of charge.

Taking into consideration the limited prayer i.e. for registration of the case and the reply submitted by the State, wherein it has specifically been mentioned that FIR has already been registered in the case, this Court finds that the present petition is rendered infructuous as the relief prayed has already been granted to the petitioner.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
