Pursuant to the order dated 14.10.2019, the report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram, dated 30.10.2019, is on record, stating to the effect that the joint statement of the petitioner Navjot Singh and respondent no.2, i.e. the complainant in the FIR, Abhinav Kapoor, was recorded before that court on the said date, to the effect that the matter had actually been compromised between them without any pressure or fear.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed and no other criminal case stated to have been registered against the petitioner (as per the affidavit of Ms. Pankhuri Kumar, Assistant Commissioner of Police, City Gurugram), FIR no.555 dated 13.11.2018, registered against the petitioner at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurugram, District Gurugram,

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for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 65, 66 of Information Technology Act, 2000 and 408, 420 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.

As regards the directions issued to the DGP, Haryana and the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, vide the aforesaid order of this court, learned State counsel has submitted that it has been communicated by the Commissioner of Police that the concerned official has been issued a warning to be careful in future.
