Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of blanket anticipatory bail in case apprehended to be registered under Sections 406, 420 of any other Section of the IPC in District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relied on agreement dated 13.11.2018 (Annexure P-2) vide which Smt. Karamjit Kaur received a sum of Rs.3 lacs as friendly loan and agreed to return the same within 6 months. On the basis of the same, civil suit has already been filed for recovery vide Civil Suit No.396-2019, which is now pending for 10.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the complainant submitted that

complainant has also submitted application dated 17.05.2019 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur for non-return of the money.

In this view of the matter, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case petitioner is required to be arrested, in that event he be given 3 days prior notice.
