Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.191 dated 26.10.2018 under Sections 376, 384, 365, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station PAU, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that case of the petitioner is covered by order dated 18.03.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-2343-2019 (Rajinder Singh Versus State of Punjab), whereby for similar set of circumstances, co-accused was admitted on bail. He further states that the petitioner is in custody since 28.11.2018 and there is no allegation of rape having been committed by the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Gursewak Singh, does not dispute the parity and the custody period.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 28.11.2018 and co-accused of the petitioner has already been admitted on bail vide order dated 18.03.2019, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
