HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.28 dated 21.01.2017 under Sections 61, 1 & 14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Zirakpur.

The petitioner was granted regular bail by learned trial Court in case FIR No.28 dated 21.01.2017 under various provisions of the Excise Act. The police has already submitted cancellation report in the said case. However, due to non-appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court, proclamation proceedings have been initiated against him. Due of which, bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled vide order dated 10.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) and his bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited by the State. The petitioner was summoned through non-bailable warrants.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there was no intention on the part of the petitioner to violate the process of law. The

petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and to participate in the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anu Pal, DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner may appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate on or before 10.07.2019. On his doing so, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court. The petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court as and when required. He shall remain bound by the undertaking.
