Petitioner Chandan alias Pintu by way of this invocation under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has sought interim regular bail in case bearing FIR No.466 dated 23.10.2015 under Sections 302, 307, 341, 212, 120B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act pertaining to Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr.Virender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Law and Order, Sonipat on behalf of the respondent/State along with the supporting documents, reports from various respectables of the area and the marriage invitation card detailing therein that marriages of two brothers of the petitioner namely Angad Singh and Ratnakar Singh are to be solemnized on 10th and 15th of June, 2019 respectively.

In the light of contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that presence of the petitioner being real brother of the bridegrooms, at the time of marriages is very much necessary and essential as per the customs and rituals of the society; this Court is of the view that it would be in the fitness of things and in the interest of justice, if the petitioner is allowed interim regular bail for a period of six days with effect from 10.06.2019, subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.3.00 lacs with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonipat and the petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, Tihar Jail, New Delhi on 16.06.2019 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
