Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 5.2.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar as also order dated 15.3.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Collector, Jalandhar.

Pleadings on record would indicate that a sale deed was executed in the year 2009 pertaining to 4 kanals 17 marlas and in which private respondents no.4 to 6 herein were the vendees.

It is the case of the petitioner that the actual sale consideration was of Rs.55 lakhs, whereas stamp duty has been affixed on a sale consideration of Rs.7,30,000/- only.

A complaint/application was moved by the present petitioner after a period of almost nine years from the date of execution of the sale deed calling upon the official respondents to recover the deficient stamp duty from the private respondents.

During the course of arguments counsel has not been able to advert to any particular provision of the Indian Stamp Act under which the complaint had been filed by the petitioner. Counsel has also not been able to demonstrate to this Court the interest that petitioner has in the property in

question.

Faced with a situation where this Court was not inclined to intervene, counsel seeks withdrawal of the petition.

Prayer is allowed.
