Inter alia contends that the petitioner had put in appearance in a complaint case filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and had been released on regular bail on 08.10.2018. However, appearance was not put in 16.11.2018, whereby non-bailable warrants were issued for 18.12.2018. Reference is made to the railway ticket (Annexure P-5 colly.) to submit that the petitioner from Jodhpur had reached Ludhiana on 18.12.2018, but on account of non-bailable warrants issued, he did not appear. The anticipatory bail has been rejected on 09.05.2019 (Annexure P-4).

It is submitted that the petitioner undertakes to put in appearance on the next date of hearing, which is now fixed for 09.07.2019.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, the petitioner shall put in appearance on 09.07.2019 and file a regular bail application, which shall be decided by the Trial Court on the same date.

During the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner is granted interim protection of arrest, subject to his putting in appearance on the said date.
