Petitioner seeks a Mandamus directing the respondents to register and grant enrollment to them in the State Register maintained by the State of Punjab for practice under the Indian System of Medicines as Vaidyas in the State of Punjab.

As per pleadings on record, petitioners have either done Ayurved Rattan or Vaidya Visharad from Hindi Sahitya Sammelan, Prayag (U.P.).

Counsel during the course of hearing was repeatedly called upon to advert to the particular provision which carries a mandate for the petitioners to be registered within the State of Punjab so as to enable them to practice as Vaidyas under the Indian System of Medicines. The response has been evasive.

Under such circumstances, the prayer made in the instant petition cannot be even examined and looked into.

At this stage, counsel seeks withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to file a petition afresh with better particulars and by placing on record the relevant rules/instructions governing the field against the backdrop of the prayer made in the petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
