GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in a case registered vide FIR No.146, dated 7.3.2019, Police Station City, Narnaul, under Section 25 of Arms Act.
2. The allegations, in nutshell, are that upon receipt of a secret information to the effect that the petitioner was sitting in his car bearing registration No.HR-35N-5207 and was carrying a pistol, a raid was conducted and the petitioner was found in possession of a country made pistol along with two live bullets.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and that in any case the investigation is complete and challan has been presented.
4. Opposing the petition, the learned State counsel has submitted that since the petitioner is involved in one more case under Sections 148, 149, 327 and 195-A IPC, no case for grant of bail is made out.
5. Having considered rival submissions addressed before this Court and bearing in mind the fact that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last more than 3 months and that challan has already been presented, to my mind no useful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. The petition, as such, is accepted and petitioner Devender @ Bholu is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
6. The present petition stands accepted accordingly
