The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that the order dated 21.8.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 24244 of 2013 has not been complied with. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Resultantly, keeping in view the above, this Court has no hesitation in allowing the present writ petition and setting aside the order dated 18.06.2012 qua respondent No.5 whereby he has been permitted to be transferred mutually to the respondent No.4- Chaudhary Devi Lal Sugar Mill at Gohana District Sonapat. Resultantly, the petitioner's claim for promotion to the post of the said Fitter-II (Seasonal) will, accordingly, be considered w.e.f. the date the vacancy arose within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of this order."

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Ashish Kumar, HCS, Managing Director, Ch. Devi Lal Coop. Sugar Mill Ltd. Gohana annexing the order dated 13.09.2018, same is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the copy of the order dated 13.09.2018 has already been supplied to the petitioner and his signatures are also there on the endorsement of the order.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdraw with liberty as prayed for.
