Issue notice of motion.

Mr. Narender Bhukal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 & 3 and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record. It is stated by him that he has no objection, if the present appeal is allowed.

From the perusal of impugned order dated 18.03.2019, it is evident that the present appellant is the wife of Subhash Chand and in his capacity, his wife has also been appointed as Manager and Guardian of the Estate and the person of Subhash Chand on account of his ill health.

It is stated that huge amount of money has already been spent on treatment and now the family is under huge debt and they have no other source of income except the properties, whereas, Subhash Chand continuously needs medical treatment on account of his brain hemorrhage.

Accordingly, out of the properties as mentioned in para 5 of the impugned order dated 18.03.2019, this Court deems it proper in the facts and circumstances to permit to sale of the land in which Subhash Chand is owner in possession to the extent of 1/4th share of total land measuring 16

Kanal 13 Marla comprised in Khewat No.2073/2462 situated at village Bir,

Hisar, Tehsil and District Hisar as well as the gair mumkin land measuring 4 Marla being 1/4th share out of the total land measuring 16 Kanal comprised in Khewat No.2658 min, situated at Barwala, Tehsil Barwala, District Hisar.
