Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.262 dated 16.11.2018, under Sections 323 IPC and Section 10 of the POSCO Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Women Jind, District Jind.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 03.12.2018. There are similar allegations against the co-accused Mannu son of Bhira and Deepak son of Bharat, who are already on regular bail. He further states that since the petitioner has lodged FIR against the brother of the complainant i.e FIR no. 158 dated 15.11.2018, under Sections 323,324 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Alewa, District Jind, the present FIR has been registered against him. He refers to the order passed by this Court in CRM-M-61749 of 2018 Deepak versus State of Haryana dated 25.03.2019, where co-accused Deepak was admitted on bail.

Learned State counsel has not been able to controvert the argument as regard grant of bail to the similarly situated co-accused.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the case file.

Considering the fact that the co-accused is on bail and petitioner is in custody since 03.12.2018, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
