The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.158 dated 30.04.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452 and 506 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of a sudden fight between the residents of the same village and the petitioners have been attributed only simple injuries.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 06.06.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 06.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
