Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.73 dated 04.05.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on vide diary No.42 dated 27.05.2019), registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 06.06.2019: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia has argued that petitioners, namely, Karanpreet Singh @ K.P., Akash @ Chhotu and Arun have been attributed injuries on non-vital part of the body of the complainant, namely, Danishpreet Singh and which have been belatedly declared all grievous on the report of the private medical institution and has sought to debate the

applicability of Section 326 of the Indian Penal Code...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 06.06.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
