Petitioners herein who claim to have attained the age of majority are stated to be living together, even though not married.

Counsel submits that both the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8 and who are immediate/close blood relations of petitioner No.1.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners, having perused the pleadings on record and without opining on the relationship between the parties, writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the Superintendent of Police, Palwal as regards their threat perception and which has been voiced in the instant writ petition.

In the eventuality of any such application being moved by the petitioners before respondent No.2, he would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
