The present revision petition is filed with the delay of 103 days.

The paper book also shows that although the petitioner was convicted and sentenced by the trial Court, his appeal was also dismissed by the Lower Appellate Court, despite that, the petition has been filed without surrendering to the Court so as to serve the sentence in accordance with law.

Otherwise also, the application filed for condonation of delay states that the appeal filed by the petitioner against his conviction was dismissed on 08.09.2017 and the petitioner came to know of decision of the case by the Lower Appellate Court after having received the summons of non-bailable warrants (whatever it means). However, the facts remains that till today, the petitioner has not surrendered to the process of the Court.

In view of the above, finding no sufficient cause, the application for condonation of delay of 103 days in filing the present petition is dismissed.
