State counsel has filed in Court today a response by way of affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalka on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. The same is taken on record.

Para 3 of the reply reads in the following terms :-

“That in compliance of order dated 12-06-2019 passed by this Hon'ble Court, representation dated 31-05-2019 submitted by the petitioners was considered and their statements were recorded. Both the petitioners have stated in their statements that they have performed their marriage on 31 May 2019 with their own consent against the wishes of their parents. Brothers of petitioner No.1 i.e. respondent No.4 to 6 were not happy from this marriage and were threatening to them. In this regard the above said writ petition was filed by them before this Hon'ble Court to protect the life and liberty from the hands of respondent

No.4 to 6. That now respondent No.4 and 6 are agree with their marriage and there is no danger to them from respondent No.4 to 6 or any one. Now petitioners are residing as wife and husband at Village Khera Sita Ram Kalka, near Baba Balak Nath Mandir, Kalka. Both the petitioners have further stated that there is no danger to them and no need of police help. After consideration the representation of the petitioners was filed.”

In view of the stand taken in the reply and particularly in para 3 thereof, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant writ petition.
