Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sheela Devi in case FIR No.119 dated 03.04.2019 under Sections 306/34 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District-Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the present case, the abatement was alleged to have been made on 20.02.2019 whereas deceased Sandeep Singh passed away on 14.04.2019. He further states that poison was consumed by Sandeep Singh after 35 days i.e on 27.3.2019. He further states that there are other co-accused who have been challaned. Co-accused Randhir Singh, husband of the petitioner Sheela Devi and Ompati, against whom similar allegations were levelled by the complainant, have been granted anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad, whereas co-accused Devi Lal has been granted regular bail by the trial Court.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the bail

application.

In the present case, challan has been presented against the petitioner and the other co-accused. Petitioner-Sheela Devi was arrested on 19.04.2019. As mentioned above, co-accused Randhir Singh and Om Pati have already been granted anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad, whereas co-accused Devi Lal has been granted regular bail by the trial Court.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, it is made clear that the observation made above shall be confined to the present petition and the same shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
