By this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

The petitioner has been in custody for more than 4 and ½ months, with the challan still to be presented and no other criminal case seen to be registered against him, with the recovery stated to be made from him being 30 m.l. of 'Buprenorphine' injections, the commercial quantity being 20 m.l.

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to admit him to bail during the pendency of the trial.

The petition is therefore allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
