Petitioners Jyoti Bala and Vinay Kumar have averred that they have married against wishes of respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner No.1. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of her Matriculation Certificate and petitioner No.2 has annexed copy of his Aadhar Card indicating that they are aged 23 years and 33 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, Punjab to look into the representation Annexure P-5 made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
