This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents to produce detenue-Neetu wife of the petitioner before this Court.

Detenue-Neetu is present in Court. She has submitted that she is major and validly married with the petitioner and they sought protection from this Court vide CRM-M-20473-2019 on 6.5.2019 (Annexure P-4). She has categorically stated that she is willing to go with her husband-Vivek Kumar petitioner who is present in Court.

Vivek Kumar-petitioner voluntarily undertakes to deposit a

sum of ₹ 50,000/- in the name of his wife-Neetu in the shape of FDR in some nationalized bank within one month.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that detenue-Neetu is allowed to go with her husband Vivek Kumar-petitioner.
