Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 – Priya Kour, aged 19 years and petitioner No.2 – Deepak Masih, aged 23 years have got married against the wishes of their family members, arrayed as respondents No.4 to 7. It has further been submitted that the private respondents are threatening to interfere in the marital life of the petitioners. Hence, they are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Batala to look into the representation dated 31.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) and take necessary steps, if

any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the parties and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
