Prayer in this application is for disposal of the writ petition in the light of the settlement/compromise dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure A-1).

Notice of the application.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Mr. M.P.S.Mann, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 8 and 9. Mr. Ajay Aggarwal, Advocate, for Mr. Denesh Goyal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 11 to 57 and Mr. Rajiv Kataria, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 58 to 64.

Counsel for the State submits that it is a private issue and in the light of the settlement, he has no objection to the prayer made in the application. Counsel for the private respondents, except for respondents No. 8 and 9, accept the factum of compromise which has been entered into.

Counsel for respondents No. 8 and 9 submits that respondents

No. 8 and 9 are not signatories to the said compromise, however, if the petitioners, in the light of the compromise which has been entered into between the parties, intend to withdraw the writ petition, he has no objection to the same.

In the light of the above, the present application is allowed.
