The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0036 dated 25.05.2019, under Sections 452, 506, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahpurkandi, Tehsil and District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR has been lodged after two days of the incident and the injuries which have allegedly been caused by the petitioners are simple in nature.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 06.06.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 06.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
