Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft dated 2.12.2019 for a sum of Rs. 5 lacs. Revalidated demand draft dated 2.12.2019 for a sum of Rs. 20 lacs has also been handed over accompanied by a demand draft dated 05.12.2019 for a sum of Rs. 1 lac. Photocopies of the same have been retained on record and the original demand drafts have been handed over to counsel for respondent No. 2. A sum of Rs. 4 lacs has been paid in cash.

In view of the above, order dated 18.11.2019 stands complied with. Since full and final payments have been made, respondent No. 2 is directed to re-transfer the property in favour of the petitioner. The parties would be at liberty to move an appropriate petition for getting the FIR quashed.

The petition is allowed and interim order dated 06.06.2019 is made absolute.
