Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.238 dated 24.12.2017 registered under Sections 379, 188, 285 IPC, 25/54/59 of the Arms Act and 4 of the Mines Act, 1952 at Police Station Tigaon, Faridabad, District Faridabad, on the basis of the compromise effected between the parties.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. The situation was not different even on the last two dates of hearing.

Vide order dated 10.06.2019, notice of motion was issued as it was observed that there is a compromise between the parties.

Thereafter, the petitioner was re-directed to join the investigation as on the last date, it was objected by the Investigating Officer that the petitioner has joined the investigation but has failed to co-operate and has not handed over the weapon used in the occurrence.

Thereafter, the petitioner was again re-directed to rejoin the investigation and co-operate with the investigation and it was

clarified that the interim protection shall stand vacated, if he fails to hand over the weapon used in the occurrence.

Today, counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has still not handed over the weapon used in the occurrence despite giving sufficient opportunities to join the investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed.
