Petitioner seeks a mandamus to direct the respondent/ authorities not to transfer him from one jail in the State of Punjab to another as the same amounts to harassment. Further grievance raised in the petition is that the petitioner who is currently lodged in Central Jail, Faridkot is being meted out inhuman treatment at the hands of the Jail Superintendent concerned.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard and the case paper book has been perused.

Apparently, the petitioner is involved in as many as 20 criminal proceedings. Petitioner seems to be a habitual offender and counsel concedes that he has been classified as a 'A' category gangster.

The averments are completely vague as regards the harassment and maltreatment alleged to have been meted out to him.

Against the backdrop of the averments contained in the instant writ petition, the prayer raised is not well founded.

No intervention in the matter is warranted.

Petition is dismissed.
