The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.07 dated 22.03.2019, registered under sections 354-A (2), 354-D, 376, 506, 511 IPC, at Police Station Women, District Charkhi Dadri.

The allegation against the petitioner is that were calling the prosecutrix on her mobile phone. Even the call details have been placed on record showing that both the petitioner and the prosecutrix were calling each other. It is further the case of the prosecution that on 13.03.2019, when the prosecutrix was going to her plot at 5:00 a.m. then accused caught hold her and threw her on the ground. He tried to do wrong thing with her but she raised alarm and rescued herself.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 25.03.2019. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Manjeet Khatri is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
