ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.52 dated 14.05.2019, under Sections 323, 307 & 34 IPC registered at Police Station Rahon, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that only simple injuries have been attributed to the petitioner who is 75 years of age. The petitioner had also received injuries in the occurrence. It is the case of version and cross-version wherein the petitioner had also received injuries.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 10.06.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Harpal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
