Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no requirement of issuing notice of motion to respondents no.4 and 5.

Petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent no.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 22.04.2019 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, if found

necessary, within a period of four weeks'.
