On 7.11.2019, the following order had been passed:-

“Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI
Balwinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined
investigation and his custodial interrogation is presently not
required.

Since counsel for the complainant is not present, it
being well past 4:00 p.m, adjourned to 15.11.2019.

Today, though Mr.Jattana, who is said to be the 'arguing
counsel' for the complainant, is not present, and a pass over is requested.
However, since learned State counsel again reiterates, on instructions from
ASI Balwinder Singh, that the petitioners' custodial interrogation is
presently not required, without any prejudice to the rights of the

complainant to seek any remedy that he wishes to, the petition is disposed of, with the interim order dated 23.9.2019 made absolute, subject to the same terms and conditions.
