As per pleadings on record, petitioner No.1 is stated to have instituted a civil suit for possession and for eviction by way of mandatory injunction a portion of the suit property/Dargah as also for recovery of Rs.1,30,000/- as mesne profit for wrongful use and occupation of the suit property against private respondents No.5 and 6 and which is still pending.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that respondent No.4 i.e. SHO, Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana, under the influence of private respondents No.5 and 6 is harassing and threatening the petitioner to withdraw the suit.

In the light of the grievance raised and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the writ petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the Commission of Police, Ludhiana, Punjab, as regards the grievance raised in the instant petition.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred by the petitioner, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and in accordance with law.
