The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.110 dated 18.11.2015, registered under Sections 376, 342, 34 IPC at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar.

It has been argued on behalf of the petitioner that now compromise has been effected with the prosecutrix.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

To the mind of this Court, Section 376 IPC is a non-compoundable offence. However, serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations levelled

against the petitioner, no case is made out to grant him the benefit of regular bail.

Dismissed.
