The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.211, dated 09.10.2018, under Sections 394, 379-B, 397 and 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR but has been arraigned as an accused later on in the course of investigation. He also contends that the recovery which is effected from the petitioner is ₹ 10,000/- and a motorcycle with a fake number plate. He further contends that the petitioner is 25 year of age and is not involved in any other case. The petitioner is in custody since 11.10.2018 and co-accused, namely, Randeep Singh @ Rana has already been granted regular bail by this Court in **CRM-M-24093 of 2019** on 30.05.2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, states that although investigation has been completed but the charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for about nine months, he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
