The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to re-check question Nos.33, 52, 65, 69 & 85 and correct the answers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that answer keys uploaded by respondent No.2/Haryana Staff Selection Commission, were not having correct answers, in respect of five questions only. Though, the petitioner failed to submit any objection. Respondent No.2/HSSC has not taken or referred the matter to the Expert Committee to examine at their end, despite the fact that detailed representation dated 05.04.2019 (Annexure P-4) has been submitted.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s)/State

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and submitted that result was declared way back on 28.02.2019 and the petitioner has not submitted any objection to the answer keys at that time, thus, urges this Court for dismissal of the present writ petition.

Keeping in view the fact that the result was declared much before i.e. on 28.02.2019 and at that time, the petitioner has not submitted any objection to the answer key, it is too late in a day to put clock back to dispute the answer key as much time has elapsed.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is devoid of merit and the same is hereby dismissed.
