This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 91 dated 03.09.2018, registered under Sections 365, 342, 330, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits as per the allegations in the FIR, got registered on the statement of one Jagjit Singh @ Jagga, it is stated that complainant was working as a labourer with Jagtar Singh and Bachittar Singh and on the allegation that the complainant has taken away two cots of the aforesaid persons, the accused persons caught the complainant and tied his arms on his back with the help of a rope and gave him beatings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in fact the dispute has been settled with the complainant and relies upon Annexures P-2 and P-3 in this regard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is in judicial custody since 22.04.2019; challan already stands presented and the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raghvinder Prasad, has not disputed the factual position, however, the Investigating Officer pleaded ignorance about the compromise between the parties.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 22.04.2019 and the matter stands compromised between the parties; the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
