AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that in the light of the circular dated 21.07.2014 (Annexure P-24), petitioner would make a detailed representation to the Central Provident Fund Commissioner, New Delhi, within a period of three weeks putting forth contentions including the ones which have been made in the present writ petition, which representation may be considered and decided by the said authority within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the learned senior counsel for the petitioner, present writ petition is disposed of without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed/comprehensive representation to the Central Provident Fund

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Commissioner, New Delhi, within a period of three weeks from today. In case such a representation is made within the time as mentioned above, the same shall be considered and decision taken thereon by the said authority within a period of two months from the date of submission of such representation.

It goes without saying that the orders which are under challenge in the present writ petition should not, in any manner, influence the decision of the Central Provident Fund Commissioner, New Delhi and he would decide the representation with an open mind in accordance with law.
