The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents no.6 to12 and restraining them to harass the innocent persons of the society as despite representation dated 30.05.2019 (Annexure P-2), no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Additional A.G. Punjab with Mr. Amit Mehta, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondent Nos.1 to 3. Copy of complete paper book be supplied to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, a direction is issued to respondent no.2 / Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, Tehsil and District Hoshiarpur, Punjab to look into the representation dated 30.05.2019 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and dispose of the same within 60 days. Further it is directed that if the situation so demands, the petitioners be also provided protection.
