The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 13.06.2018, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148 & 149 IPC (Sections 325, 326 & 450 IPC added later on) (Section 452 IPC deleted), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injury which is attributed to the petitioner in the FIR is on the right wrist of the complainant but in the MLR of the complainant, there is no injury on the right wrist. The petitioner is in custody since 19.04.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Lakhveer Singh, is not in a position to controvert the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. She, however, states that although the challan has been filed but no witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when he is in custody for nearly 3 months and the conclusion of

the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
