The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.154 dated 20.05.2019, under Sections 147, 148, 323 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Kaosla, Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR. Only simple injuries are alleged to have been caused in the incident.

This Court, by the order dated 18.06.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sube Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 18.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
