Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of appropriate direction for registration of FIR under the relevant provisions of IPC against the accused.

Pursuant to the order dated 16.07.2019 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioner has filed an affidavit of the petitioner in Court today, which is taken on record.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has informed this Court that though the police has registered an FIR against the accused, but the same has not been registered for the relevant offences as detailed in the complaint.

This Court finds that it is only during the course of investigation, the petitioner may have a genuine grouse and this Court expects that once the

FIR has been registered, it must be fairly investigated. Therefore, no such direction as prayed in the petition can be issued at this stage.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
