RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 9 and for not harassing him on any false criminal complaint, if lodged by the respondent Nos.6 to 8 and any of their relatives.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representations (Annexure P-4 and P-5) in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, respondent No.2-The Director General of Police, Punjab, is directed to look into the said representations (Annexures P-4 and P-5) and decide the same, as per law within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However,

petitioner's case be considered with regard to providing adequate protection,
at the earliest.

With aforesaid direction, writ petition stands disposed of.
