The parties have mutually settled the matter in dispute, which has emanated on account of dishonouring of cheque of Rs.3,09,815/- issued by the petitioner to the complainant. Out of the cheque amount of Rs.3,09,815/- a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- has already been paid by the petitioner to the complainant as stated by the parties in their statements and have endorsed the statements made here.

Now the parties have agreed for clinching the matter in full and final payment of Rs.2,00,000/- more, out of which Rs.1,00,000/- has been paid by the appellant today in cash in the Court. The remaining amount of Rs.1,00,000/- has been agreed to be paid in two installments of Rs.50,000/- each and the same to be made on or before 1st August, 2019 and second on or before 1st September, 2019. The payment is to be made either by way of demand draft or in cash under receipt.

The complainant does not want to pursue the case further and raise no objection for setting the conviction on account of mutual settlement as per their statements separately.

Thus, the matter stands settled between the parties whose statements are annexed here and conviction of the petitioner-Manoj Kumar is set aside.
