ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 86, dated 24.03.2019, under Sections 323, 307 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant and the injury, for which Section 307 IPC has been invoked, is attributed to her husband. He also contends that the petitioner is 65 years old lady and is in custody for almost 3 months since her arrest on 26.03.2019.

Mr. Arun Kumar, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant and on instructions from the complainant, who is also present in Court, states that the matter has now been compromised and he has no objection if the petitioner is granted concession of regular bail.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is over 65 years of age and she is in custody for almost 3 months, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
