For the reasons stated in the application, criminal revision petition is restored to its original number.

Main petition

With the consent of learned counsel for the petitioner, the case is taken on Board for final disposal.

This Court has heard the learned counsel for the petitioner at length.

It has been noticed that learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kurukshetra acquitted the accused, vide his detailed judgment. The aforesaid judgment has been affirmed by the Court of Session.

The present revision petition has been filed, challenging the judgments passed by the courts below.

Both the courts have given detailed reasons to hold that prosecution has failed to prove its case against the accused beyond

reasonable shadow of doubt and, therefore, benefit of doubt has been given to the accused.

Learned counsel for the appellant, although, made sincere attempt, however, could not point out any substantive error or material irregularity in the judgments of the courts below.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is dismissed, being devoid of any merit. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, in terms thereof.
