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*TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.*

Petitioners seek mandamus directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel submits that respondent No.5-Paras Nath has filed a complaint against the son of the petitioners on the allegations that his daughter has eloped with him/has been abducted by him.

Learned counsel argues that against the backdrop of such complaint, the police officials are harassing the petitioners and have been threatened that they will be put inside the lock-up and would be tortured.

Having perused the case paper book, this Court is of the view that the averments on record are completely vague.

The copy of the complaint alleged to have been made by

respondent No.5 has not been placed on record. Learned counsel is not in a position to give a concrete response as to whether any FIR has been registered or not.

The averments in the petition are not sufficient for this Court to infer any threat to the petitioners as no specific instances have been cited.

In view of the above, no interference in the matter is called for at this stage.

Petition is dismissed.
